

Manager of Operations **(Gloucester County Utilities Authority)**

Must currently hold both NJDEP S4 and C4 licenses in good standing.

Experience with Activated sludge process a necessity.

Experience with Anaerobic Digestion desirable.

As the licensed operator of record, responsible for meeting all permit parameter and reporting requirements.

This includes NJPDES surface water permit. (The surface water permit covers entire Treatment plant and the Pitman golf course ultra-filtration plant).

Air permit which covers all air related processes. This includes sludge incinerators, natural gas blower, and all odor control equipment.

Responsible for all other permits, both state and federal.

Responsible for oversight of the Industrial Pretreatment Program. This includes both permitted and non-permitted industries, and all trucked in waste streams.

Responsible for oversight and preparation of annual operating budget (\$25 million).

Directly corresponds with consultants and regulatory agents on all aspects, including wastewater treatment and conveyance, construction both new and rehabilitative, regulatory issues, and legal issues.

All operational, laboratory, maintenance, engineering, and industrial pretreatment department heads report directly to the Manager of Operations.

The Manager of Operations handles all union/personnel issues if issues cannot be resolved at the supervisory level.

Handles any issues that arise with towns that are serviced by the GCUA. Directly corresponds with residents who may have issues with GCUA.

Handles all requests issued from Executive Director in a timely manner.

Compensation to be determined by years of working experience and familiarity with facility processes.
