

TOWNSHIP OF DEPTFORD SCHOOL DISTRICT

PUBLIC QUESTION TO BE VOTED UPON

PROPOSAL

Shall The Board of Education of the Township of Deptford, in the County of Gloucester, New Jersey ("School District"), be authorized to: (a) undertake for lawful school purposes, a capital improvement program consisting of (i) construction of a new additions to the **Monongahela Middle School**, to accommodate new classrooms and other academic space as well as new central School District administrative offices, together with interior renovations to the main office, science labs, teacher work rooms, cafeteria and gymnasium, exterior renovations to windows, doors, parking areas and driveways, HVAC improvements and electrical system upgrades at that facility, (ii) renovations to science labs and HVAC improvements at the **Deptford High School**, and (iii) replacement of the gymnasium floors at the **Central Early Childhood Center, Pine Acres Early Childhood Center and Shady Lane Elementary School**, together with the acquisition of all equipment and the completion of all work necessary or desirable to make said improvements compatible with the existing facilities; (b) expend for all the foregoing an amount not to exceed \$37,616,854 (\$22,232,587 of which represents eligible costs ("Final Eligible Costs"), as determined by the Commissioner of Education); (c) issue bonds of the School District for said project in an amount not to exceed \$37,616,854, in which event the State will pay 40% of the debt service (principal and interest) of the school bonds issued to finance the Final Eligible Costs; and (d) transfer unexpended bond proceeds between said school facility projects. This school facilities project includes \$15,384,267 for school facility construction elements in addition to the facility efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or that are not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g)*.
