

PROPOSAL I

Shall The Board of Education of the Township of Mantua, in the County of Gloucester, New Jersey ("School District"), be authorized to: (a) undertake for lawful school purposes, a capital improvement program consisting of (i) construction of six (6) new kindergarten classrooms and new central district offices, renovations to security vestibule, replacement of gym floor, playground resurfacing, acquisition of land, drainage improvements, demolition of certain existing structures and construction of new parking lots, HVAC improvements and technology upgrades at the **Sewell Elementary School**, (ii) renovations to security vestibule and interior walls, acquisition of furnishings and equipment, HVAC improvements and technology upgrades at the **Centre City Elementary School**, (iii) renovations to security vestibule, replacement of gym floor, acquisition of furnishings and equipment, HVAC improvements and technology upgrades at the **J. Mason Tomlin Elementary School**, and (iv) the completion of such other work and improvements, and acquisition of furniture, fixtures and equipment as may be necessary therefor or related to the projects set forth above; (b) expend for all the foregoing an amount not to exceed \$9,650,000 (\$4,714,280 of which represents eligible costs ("Proposal I Final Eligible Costs"), as determined by the Commissioner of Education); (c) issue bonds of the School District for said project in an amount not to exceed \$9,650,000, in which event the State will pay 40% of the debt service (principal and interest) of the school bonds issued to finance the Proposal I Final Eligible Costs; and (d) transfer unexpended bond proceeds between said school facility projects. This school facilities project includes \$4,935,720 for school facility construction elements in addition to the facility efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or that are not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g)*.

PROPOSAL II

If Proposal I is approved by the voters, shall the School District also be authorized to: (a) undertake for lawful school purposes, a capital improvement program consisting of: (i) construction of new pre-kindergarten bathrooms and classroom flooring renovations at the **Sewell Elementary School**, (ii) resurfacing of playgrounds and classroom flooring renovations at the **Centre City Elementary School**, (iii) resurfacing of playgrounds at the **J. Mason Tomlin Elementary School**; and (iv) the completion of such other work and improvements, and acquisition of furniture, fixtures and equipment as may be necessary therefor or related to the projects set forth above; (b) expend for all the foregoing an amount not to exceed \$1,385,250 (all of which represents eligible costs ("Proposal II Final Eligible Costs"), as determined by the Commissioner of Education); (c) issue bonds of the School District for said project in an amount not to exceed \$1,385,250, in which event the State will pay 40% of the debt service (principal and interest) of the school bonds issued to finance the Proposal II Final Eligible Costs; and (d) transfer unexpended bond proceeds between said school facility projects. This school facilities project includes \$0 for school facility construction elements in addition to the facility efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or that are not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g)*.
