

NJ TRANSIT Access Link

NJ TRANSIT operates Access Link for people with disabilities who are unable to use the local fixed route bus. You must apply for eligibility. Your origin and destination must be within 3/4 mile of a NJ TRANSIT bus route. Access link is a full fare service. These NJ TRANSIT routes provide convenient transfer access to PATCO, SEPTA, Greyhound and the River Line. In addition, you can transfer to buses to Atlantic City at the Walter Rand Transportation Center in Camden, Avandale Park n Ride or the Vineland Transportation Center. NJ Transit Route #553 serving the Vineland Transportation Center also operates many trips to the Cumberland County College.

Exact Fare-On many bus routes, passengers are required to have exact fare in coins or \$1 bills. Drivers do not carry money and cannot make change. If you are a frequent rider, the ten-trip ticket and monthly pass are good alternatives to using exact change daily.

FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP: NJ TRANSIT 313, 408. Franklin Township municipal shuttle is open to all Franklin residents. Anyone age 16 or under must be accompanied by an adult. The shuttle operates to shopping malls, food markets and recreational activities almost every Tuesday and Thursday. The shuttle operates to the nutrition center Monday thru Friday. Bring proof of age/disability to Park and Recreation office at South Delsea Park to obtain pass and schedule information. SWEDESBORO: NJ TRANSIT 401
WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP: NJ TRANSIT 315, 400, 403, 408, 412, 463. Municipal shuttle bus services are available to Senior Citizens aged 55 and over, as well as Disabled Township Residents who can maneuver on their own. The route operates to the Senior Center and to various shopping centers within the Township on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. NJ TRANSIT REDUCED BUS FARE PROGRAM

Senior Citizens (62 and older) and passengers with disabilities can travel on-board NJ TRANSIT trains, buses and light rail vehicles at a reduced fare of one-half the regular fare or lower. Senior Citizens (62 and older) may be asked to present a valid ID (any ID or document printed with your date of birth and issued by a government, social service, or mass transportation agency) to obtain the reduced fare. Valid ID for seniors (65 and older) also includes the MTA Reduced Fare Card, PA Senior Citizen Transit ID or PACE Card, PATH Senior Fare Card or Medicare Card. You do not have to be a New Jersey resident to be eligible.

Senior Citizens and people with disabilities who do not have a Medicare card may obtain a Reduced ID/Card by applying to NJ Transit. Call 1(973) 378-6401 for more information.

All military personnel and their dependents will be permitted to purchase transportation at the senior citizen/passenger with disabilities reduced fare rate upon showing their military or military dependent ID card. The following military personnel are entitled to this fare: Active Duty, Reserve, National Guard or Retired for Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or Coast Guard.

Eligible passengers may ride at the reduced rate on NJ TRANSIT bus, rail or light rail at all times without restriction upon presentation of authorized identification.

Children ages 5 through 11 save 50% or more off regular one-way fares at all times. Up to three children, ages 4 and under, ride free with a passenger paying any valid fare.

Family Supersaver Fares are available on trains, buses and light rail vehicles during weekends and holidays from 7pm Friday (or the day before a holiday) until 6am Monday (or the day after a holiday). Two children ages 5 through 11 may travel free with a passenger paying any valid fare.

NJ TRANSIT Monthly Interstate and Intrastate passes can save you time and money. For one discounted monthly price you can travel an unlimited number of times within the zone range indicated on your pass

Discounted Ten-Trip Tickets are available for intrastate travel in zones 3 through 23 and interstate travel in zones 2 through 21. They are valid for 20 days from date of sale. They are not available on board the bus.

Monthly passes and ten-trip tickets may be purchased at NJ TRANSIT ticket agencies or terminals or through NJ TRANSIT Mail Fare. Call 1(800) 648-0215 for additional information.

Transfers are available for use by one-way full fare-paying passengers whose complete trip must be made using two buses (within New Jersey only). They must be purchased at the time of boarding the first bus. Pay the regular fare to the transfer point, plus the transfer charge. Transfers are accepted for a one-zone ride on the connecting bus. Riders going beyond one zone must pay additional zone charges. Transfers are valid for two hours after issued.

Service is provided to all areas of Gloucester County, with limited service to Camden, Cumberland and Salem Counties and portions of Philadelphia.
