**EXHIBIT L – CHILDREN’S HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM  
REAUTHORIZATION ACT OF 2009**

On February 4, 2009, the Children’s Health Insurance Program Reauthorization Act of 2009 (“CHIPRA”) was enacted. The purpose of CHIPRA is to provide additional funding for health insurance for children under your state’s Children’s Health Insurance Program (“CHIP”) and Medicaid.

For more information regarding your state’s CHIP and Medicaid programs, including program eligibility requirements, please contact your state CHIP and/ or Medicaid office. In Gloucester County that office is the Division of Social Services and the number for Social Services is 582-9200.

Also, as a result of CHIPRA, there are special open enrollment options for you under our health care plan. Furthermore, you are entitled to enroll, change, or drop out of the company’s health plan if:

1. You or a dependent becomes eligible for your state’s CHIP or Medicaid Plan; or
2. You or a dependent no longer are eligible for your state’s CHIP or Medicaid program and such coverage is terminated.

Please note that ***you must request coverage under the company’s healthcare plan no later than 60 days*** after the date you or your dependent is determined to be eligible or eligibility is lost for your state’s CHIP or Medicaid program.
