

PUBLIC QUESTION TO BE VOTED UPON

BOND PROPOSAL

The Board of Education of the Clearview Regional High School District in the County of Gloucester, New Jersey is authorized: (a) to undertake various renovations and improvements to its High School, Middle School, and Administration Building; (b) to undertake the necessary site work and acquire any associated equipment for such improvements; (c) to appropriate \$1,995,000 for such improvements funded, in part, with debt service aid from the State of New Jersey at the rate of 43.5316% of the projects' eligible costs; (d) to issue bonds of the School District in the amount of \$1,995,000; and (e) to transfer funds between the school facilities projects.

The final eligible cost of the projects approved by the New Jersey Commissioner of Education is \$1,838,000. The proposed improvements include \$157,000 of school facility construction elements in addition to the facilities efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g).

Interpretative Statement

If the bond proposal is approved, the Board of Education will construct two "STEM"-Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics-instructional areas for Robotics and "CAD" (computer-aided design) in the High School, and the approval will enable the Board of Education to enhance the overall technology infrastructure and capacity in the Middle School and High School.
