Accreditation Team Invites Public Comment

The Gloucester County Prosecutor's Office is scheduled for an on-site assessment as part of the process to maintain accreditation by verifying that it meets recognized professional best practices.

Administered by the New Jersey State Association of Chiefs of Police, the accreditation program requires agencies to comply with best practice standards in five basic function areas: administrative, personnel, operations, investigative, and arrestee/detainee/prisoner handling.

Agency employees and the public are invited to offer comments by calling 856-384-5559 on Sunday, November 11, 2018 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m., during which comments will be taken by the Assessment Team. Telephone comments are limited to five minutes and must address the agency's ability to comply with the NJSACOP standards.
