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**Convenience Bathrooms in the Basement Consent Form:**

The definition of a convenience bathroom in a basement (i.e., those bathrooms not associated with a bedroom, separate dwelling unit, or to serve a kitchen) of a new or existing home.

1. The existing or proposed use of the ejector pump is for a convenience bathroom only.
2. All existing system components to be used in the system must be inspected in accordance with the inspection requirements of N.J.A.C. 7:9A-12.6. The Gloucester County Health Department does not issue waivers for existing systems where there might be an existing problem that could be exacerbated.
3. The system must be altered to meet all current requirements for pretreatment units. If a septic tank is to be used, it must meet the 50% oversizing requirements, multiple compartments (or separate tanks in series), and an effluent filter at least 6" in diameter. Alternatively, an advanced wastewater pretreatment unit may be used in addition to or possibly in lieu of a septic tank.
