All referrals to the DCBHS System of Care are made through the Contracted Systems Administrator by call **1-877-652-7624**. A clinical assessment determines the level of care a child needs. There is stabilization to preserve the child's residence. Access to services will be managed by the parent. Case Management assists the child and parent to determine and use appropriate services. Care Management helps a family create a Child and Family Team that enables the child and family to develop an Individual Service Plan (ISP) for the child.

The goal of the Division is to develop the state's prevention and early intervention systems into an integrated network of locally based, family-centered, user-friendly and culturally competent array of services and supports. The focus is to make it possible for families to get the help they need within their own communities before a crisis occurs.

Education Services

The Office of Education provides intensive 12 month educational services and supports to children and young adults ages 3 through 21. The severity or uniqueness of their needs requires removal from the public school setting for a period of time. A successful return to school and participation in community life are goals for all OOE students.

These State and federally compliant education programs are designed for students who:

- Exhibit severe cognitive, physical, behavioral and emotional disabilities;
- Exhibit a variety of moderate to severe learning disabilities;
- Are at risk of school failure; and/or
- Are pregnant/parenting teens (programs are available for infant/toddlers of parenting teens).

Regular and special education programs are individually designed and provided to these students in the least restrictive environment.
