To keep this meeting, youth and family friendly, the below reports were submitted in writing:

Care Management Organization, James Sampson: Gloucester County CIACC CGS CMO Update for the month of July 2025. CMO served 1134 families. YTD Gloucester- 636 families served. In July 2025 578 Gloucester families were served. 542 (93.77%) in-home. 36 youth (6.23%) received residential treatment. With DCP&P, CGS co-managed 63 families (10.90%). CGS served 83 DD eligible youth which was (14.36%) of Gloucester's census. In July 2025 CMO enrolled 57 new families from Gloucester County and transitioned 58 families. CGS is fully staffed. Notable trends: N/A. Notable gaps in service: N/A. Notable highlights/successes: As of June 2025 CGS Family Partnership has been serving youth and families in Cumberland, Gloucester and Salem for 20 years.

Family Support Organization, Jennifer Rodriguez: The Family Support Organization is seeking a Youth Partnership Coordinator and the job posting is on Indeed for anyone who may know someone. We just had our Family Fun Day on August 2nd and had over 200 individuals present. It was a fun filled day with some new features such as the sensory tent and cool down stations. In July we hosted 180 individuals at a Phillies Game as a family outing. On August 15th we are hosting about 100 individuals to a family outing at Morey's Pier in Wildwood. We continue to have a partnership with the Mosaic Family Success Center providing group support services to children and caregivers once a month on the 4th Monday from 4pm to 5pm. We continue our weekly group sessions in Pitman at the United Methodist Church on Thursdays from 6pm to 8pm. The youth are in their second half of Cooking Classes with Gloucester SNAP Education. They have learned how to cut vegetables, make Turkey bean tacos and Tofu and rice stir fry.

Mobile Response and Stabilization Services, Kathrine Evans: Acenda- Mobile Response report for June 2025 - 175 dispatches for the month-summer months historically show a decrease in call volume however this is an increase from June of 2024 (139 total dispatches & 73 dispatches to Glo). 56% (98/175 dispatches) were in Gloucester County, which is consistent with our average of 55-60%. So far, for 2025, we have provided in-person dispatches to 92% of our families only doing telehealth when requested by the family.

NJ DCF, Division of Child Protection & Permanency, Gloucester West Local Office, Susana Dias: We just did our book bags pick up from the Vixen's Rowing Team on 8/6. We received 174 bookbags, supplies and some lunch bags for children in Gloucester County. Gloucester West Stat's: We have 80 children in placement, we are open with 68 families and we received 183 investigations last month.
