This annual competition takes place from **August 16 – 19** at the South Point Arena and Equestrian Center in Las Vegas, Nevada. This event showcases some of the world's most talented hors-

es and riders. The competition is known for its massive cash prizes, with a total of one million dollars up for grabs. New for the TRFAM this year is the inclusion of the **\$200,000** Cutting and Cow horse challenge. According to Amanda Brumley, producer of The Run For A Million, "It was the intent from the creation of TRFAM to incorporate multiple western disciplines." The event will feature the best of the best in three disciplines: reining, cow horse, and cutting. This promises to be an epic event that has nev-

These classes took place from **April 27 – 30**, and ran concurrently with their regular classes, with the top 5 runs including ties qualifying to compete in Las Vegas.
