This year, the Gloucester County Division of Senior Services, in collaboration with The New Jersey Department of Agriculture and the New Jersey Department of Health, will again offer Seniors Farmers' Market Nutrition Programs (FMNP) benefits to eligible seniors 60 years of age and older. The program provides locally grown unprepared fresh fruits, vegetables, and herbs from local participating farmers at their roadside stands and community farmers markets.

Benefits are distributed through Senior Services, which will issue them through a QR code issued to each household. Participants will also be given lists of Certified Farmer's Vendors and community farmers' markets when they receive their electronic benefits. Each eligible senior participant will receive \$50, which can be redeemed for fresh fruits, vegetables, and herbs grown by local farmers. The FMNP benefits are valid beginning May 1 through November 30.


