"Gone to the Dogs" 10th ANNUAL CRAFT FAIR & FAMILY FESTIVAL

Based in Marlton, New Life Animal Rescue is a 501(c)3 non-profit rescue organization made up of a network of foster homes. The organization is primarily a critical care, special needs and/or hospice rescue that focuses on saving the lives of animals

who are paralyzed, blind, abused or have critical medical cases such as cleft palates. Established in 2012, the rescue has saved, rehabbed, cared for and trained over 1,000 special needs animals and has also placed them in forever homes.

The "Gone to the Dogs" festival will feature artists and crafters, food trucks, family games and dog contests! The event will also include the "Alumni Strut"!

New Jersey Thoroughbred Spectacular

The Dream Park was happy to host the first Thoroughbred Spectacular in New Jersey. This show is unique in that it is specifically for Thoroughbred horses and is TIP recognized! TIP is the Thoroughbred Incentive Program, created to encourage the retraining of Thoroughbreds into other disciplines upon completion of careers in racing or breeding.

T.I.P. offers incentives for competition horses, recreational horses, young riders and Thoroughbreds in a non-competitive second career. The Jockey Club created the Thoroughbred Incentive Program, it provides a number of programs geared toward all riders and Thoroughbreds. Generally, all information on T.I.P. programs can be found at tjctip.com, "TB Owners & Riders". As of 2024 there were 1,500 Thoroughbred T.I.P approved shows in 42 states and Canada.



Considering Racehorses start their careers at the age of two or three and their careers typically last two, maybe three years. If they're successful and remain healthy many continue racing as four or five year olds. Programs such as these give these young "off track" Thoroughbred Horse a second chance at a career. Thoroughbreds are in high demand as sport horses. You can see these talented horses succeeding in various disciplines.

Because of their athleticism and endurance they often excel as hunter/jumpers, dressage, eventing and barrel racing horses. If competition isn't of interest to the prospective owner, they often are outstanding trail riding horses.

Through a network of resources, the Jockey Club is dedicated to providing all thoroughbreds a chance to have a successful and dignified life beyond the racetrack.
