

The Goal of the Special Needs Registry is to ensure all Gloucester County Residents who may be in need of special assistance are able to get the help and support they need in a time of emergency or during interactions with Law Enforcement, Fire or EMS personnel.



The Gloucester County Special Needs Registry is a joint collaboration between the Gloucester County Chiefs Association and the Gloucester County Prosecutor's Office.



The presence of the Special Needs Registry decal signifies to first responders that someone in the residence/vehicle has some degree of special need and that they should respond accordingly. Additionally, the blue envelope is designed to help drivers with special conditions such as Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), dementia, anxiety, communications challenges, or other conditions that might impair their ability to communicate easily during a traffic stop, car accident or other on-the-road interaction with police officers.

Is there a cost to register?

Enrollment is completely free & voluntary.

Who is eligible to Register?

The registry is open to any person who lives, works, or goes to school in Gloucester county and has a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activities due to a physical and/or intellectual disability. Some examples include:

Alzheimer's/Dementia, Autism Spectrum Disorder, Diabetes, Down Syndrome, Epilepsy, Electricity or Oxygen Dependent, Hard of Hearing/Deaf, Mental Illness, Intellectual/Developmental Disability, Life Threatening Allergy, Mobility Impairment, Obesity, PTSD, Sight Impairment/Blind, Speech Impairment

What will Each Registrant Receive?

- Each registrant will be provided with a window decal that can be placed on the front entrance of the registrant's residence or on the window of any vehicle in which they regularly travel.
- Additionally, each registrant will receive a blue envelope to assist special needs drivers and police officer during interactions.



The Gloucester County Special Needs Registry is a voluntary service open to all citizens with special needs who reside, attend school or are employed in Gloucester County. The registry was created to help police officers and other emergency service personnel better assist residents with special needs in the event of an emergency by providing first responders with vital information regarding a registrant's special needs, emergency contact information, physical description and current photograph of registrant.

How to register?

1. Visit any police department within Gloucester County, either in person or online, to complete the Special Needs Registry form; or
2. Go to the Gloucester County Prosecutor's Office tab on the Gloucester County's website (www.gloucestercountynj.gov), download and complete the Special Needs Registry Form under the Informative Links tab, submit completed form to any police department in Gloucester County.

All information provided on the registry will remain strictly confidential and will only be utilized by first responders during times of emergency.
