**CONTRACT BETWEEN
COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER
AND
ENVIRONMENTAL SYSTEMS RESEARCH
INSTITUTE, INC. (ESRI, INC.)**

THIS CONTRACT is made effective the 20TH day of September, 2023, by and between the **COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER**, a body politic and corporate, with offices in Woodbury, New Jersey, hereinafter referred to as "County", and **ENVIRONMENTAL SYSTEMS RESEARCH INSTITUTE, INC. (ESRI, INC.)**, with a mailing address of 380 New York Street, Redlands, California 92373, hereinafter referred to as "Vendor".

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the County has a need for maintenance, updates, software licensing and subscription renewal of geographic information systems mapping software for the Departments of Communications/Emergency Response, Economic Development, Planning, Assessment, Health, and the Prosecutor's Office; and

WHEREAS, the supplies and services related to this contract is an expansion and ultimately the support and maintenance of proprietary hardware and software which is integrally related to existing computer systems in the County and is an exception to the Local Public Contracts Law and described and provided in N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(dd); and

WHEREAS, the contract has been awarded consistent with the fair and open provisions of the Gloucester County Administrative Code and with N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et seq., which exempt this contract from competition because vendor has certified that it has not previously made and will not make a disqualifying contribution during the term of the contract; and

WHEREAS, Vendor represents that it is qualified to perform said services and desires to perform pursuant to the terms and provisions of this Contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises, agreements and other considerations made by and between the parties, the County and Vendor do hereby agree as follows:

TERMS OF AGREEMENT

1. **TERM.** The contract shall be for the period of one year, from October 4, 2023 to October 3, 2024.
2. **COMPENSATION.** Vendor shall be compensated in a total contract amount of \$25,959.00 as per Vendor's Renewal Quotation, dated October 6, 2023.

Vendor shall be paid in accordance with this contract document upon receipt of an invoice and a properly executed voucher. After approval by County, the payment voucher shall be placed in line for prompt payment.

3. **DUTIES OF VENDOR.** The specific duties of the Vendor shall be as set forth in Vendor's Renewal Quotation, dated October 6, 2023, attached hereto as Attachment A and ESRI Maintenance and

Subscription Agreement, attached hereto as Attachment B, which are incorporated in its entirety and made a part of this contract.

4. FURTHER OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTIES. During the performance of this Contract, the Vendor agrees as follows:

The Vendor or Subcontractor, where applicable, will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality, sex, veteran status or military service. Except with respect to affectional or sexual orientation and gender identity or expression, the vendor will ensure that equal employment opportunity is afforded to such applicants in recruitment and employment, and that employees are treated during employment, without regard to their age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality, sex, veteran status or military service. Such equal employment opportunity shall include, but not be limited to the following: employment, upgrading, demotion, or transfer; recruitment or recruitment advertising; layoff or termination; rates of pay or other forms of compensation; and selection for training, including apprenticeship. The Vendor agrees to post in conspicuous places, available to employees and applicants for employment, notices to be provided by the Public Agency Compliance Officer setting forth provisions of this nondiscrimination clause.

The Vendor or Subcontractor, where applicable will, in all solicitations or advertisements for employees placed by or on behalf of the vendor, state that all qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality, sex, veteran status or military service.

The Vendor or Subcontractor will send to each labor union, with which it has a collective bargaining agreement, a notice, to be provided by the agency contracting officer, advising the labor union of the Vendor's commitments under this chapter and shall post copies of the notice in conspicuous places available to employees and applicants for employment.

The Vendor or Subcontractor, where applicable, agrees to comply with any regulations promulgated by the Treasurer pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq., as amended and supplemented from time to time and the Americans with Disabilities Act.

The Vendor or Subcontractor agrees to make good faith efforts to meet targeted county employment goals established in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-5.2.

5. LICENSING AND PERMITTING. If the Vendor or any of its agents is required to maintain a license, or to maintain in force and effect any permits issued by any governmental or quasi-governmental entity in order to perform the services which are the subject of this Contract, then prior to the effective date of this Contract, and as a condition precedent to its taking effect, Vendor shall provide to County a copy of its current license and permits required to operate in the State of New Jersey, which license and permits shall be in good standing and shall not be subject to any current action to revoke or suspend, and shall remain so throughout the term of this Contract.

Vendor shall notify County immediately in the event of suspension, revocation or any change in status (or in the event of the initiation of any action to accomplish such suspension, revocation and/or change in status) of license or certification held by Vendor or its agents.

6. **NO ASSIGNMENT OR SUBCONTRACT.** This Contract may not be assigned nor subcontracted by the Vendor, except as otherwise agreed in writing by both parties. Any attempted assignment or subcontract without such written consent shall be void with respect to the County and no obligation on the County's part to the assignee shall arise, unless the County shall elect to accept and to consent to such assignment or subcontract.

7. **POLITICAL CONTRIBUTION DISCLOSURE AND PROHIBITION.** This contract has been awarded to Vendor based on the merits and abilities of Vendor to provide the goods or services described in this Contract. This contract was awarded through a non-competitive process pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et seq. The signer of this Contract does hereby certify that Vendor, its subsidiaries, assigns or principals controlling in excess of 10% of the Vendor will not make a reportable contribution during the term of the contract to any political party committee in Gloucester County if a member of that political party is serving in an elective public office of Gloucester County when the contract is awarded, or to any candidate committee of any person serving in an elective public office of Gloucester County when the contract is awarded.

8. **INSURANCE.** Vendor shall maintain general liability and Workers' Compensation insurance in amounts, for the coverages, and with carriers provided in the Agreement. Vendor shall, simultaneously with the execution of this Contract, deliver certifications of said insurance to County.

Vendor shall maintain and continue in full force and effect an insurance policy for professional liability with limits of liability provided in the Agreement. Vendor shall, simultaneously with the execution of this Contract, and as a condition precedent to its taking effect, provide to County a copy of a certificate of insurance, verifying that said insurance is and will be in effect during the term of this Contract. The County shall review the certificate for sufficiency and compliance with this paragraph, and approval of said certificate and policy shall be necessary prior to this Contract taking effect.

9. **NON-WAIVER.** The failure by either party to enforce any particular provision of this Contract, or to act upon a breach of this Contract, the other party shall not operate as or be construed as a waiver of any subsequent breach, nor a bar to any subsequent enforcement.

10. **PARTIAL INVALIDITY.** In the event that any provision of this Contract shall be or become invalid under any law or applicable regulation, such invalidity shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this Contract.

11. **NOTICES.** Notices required by this Contract shall be effective upon mailing of notice by regular and certified mail to the addresses set forth above, or by personal service, or if such notice cannot be delivered or personally served, then by any procedure for notice pursuant to the Rules of Court of the State of New Jersey.

12. **COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE LAW.** Vendor shall at all times during the course of the effective period of this Contract comply with and be subject to all applicable laws, rules and regulations of the State of New Jersey.

13. **INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR STATUS.** The parties acknowledge that Vendor is an independent contractor and is not an agent of the County.

14. **BINDING EFFECT.** This Contract shall be binding on the undersigned and their successors

and assigns.

15. GOVERNING LAW, JURISDICTION AND VENUE. This agreement and all questions relating to its validity, interpretation, performance or enforcement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.

16. CONTRACT PARTS. This contract shall consist of this document, Vendor's Renewal Quotation, dated October 6, 2023, and ESRI Maintenance and Subscription Agreement. If there is a conflict between this Contract and Vendor's Renewal Quotation and/or ESRI Maintenance and Subscription Renewal, then this Contract shall control.

THIS CONTRACT is made effective the 20th day of September, 2023.





If Customer is a government entity, the applicable laws of Customer's jurisdiction govern this Agreement without reference to conflict-of-laws principles, except that US federal law shall govern in matters of intellectual property. If Customer is a nongovernmental entity, US federal law and the law of the State of California exclusively govern this Agreement, excluding their respective choice of law principles.

ARTICLE 4—ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Agreement constitutes the sole and entire agreement of the parties as to the subject matter set forth herein and supersedes any previous agreements, understandings, and arrangements between the parties relating to such subject matter. Any modification(s) or amendment(s) to this Agreement must be in writing and signed by an authorized representative of each party.


