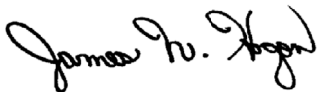
VOTERS! ATTENTION!

3. To Vote for a Public Question (if applicable) touch the 'Yes' or 'No'.
4. When you finish making your selection, touch **'Cast your Ballot'**. Stay at the booth until you see the Thank You Screen.
5. To change the screen display or language, touch the buttons in the upper right corner of the screen.
