### ➔ POLICIES

- Shuttle may deviate up to 1/8 of a mile off the route. Deviation requests must be made by 12:00 PM the day before traveling through Customer Service (856-227-7571)
- Shoes and shirts required
- Pets, smoking, eating, drinking, littering, profanity or loud music not permitted
- Harassment of riders or driver will not be tolerated
- No shuttle service on New Years Day (observed), Easter Sunday, Memorial Day, Independence Day (observed), Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, & Christmas Day (observed)

### ➔ SHUTTLE FARES

- \$1 each way. Exact fare required.
- FREE at shuttle stops marked ①, with a valid transfer or valid monthly pass from a connecting NJ TRANSIT bus route
- Free one-zone ride on connecting NJ TRANSIT buses. Request transfer from shuttle driver at stops marked ①
- Free for children under 11 accompanied by adult
- The connecting Internal Circulator is free

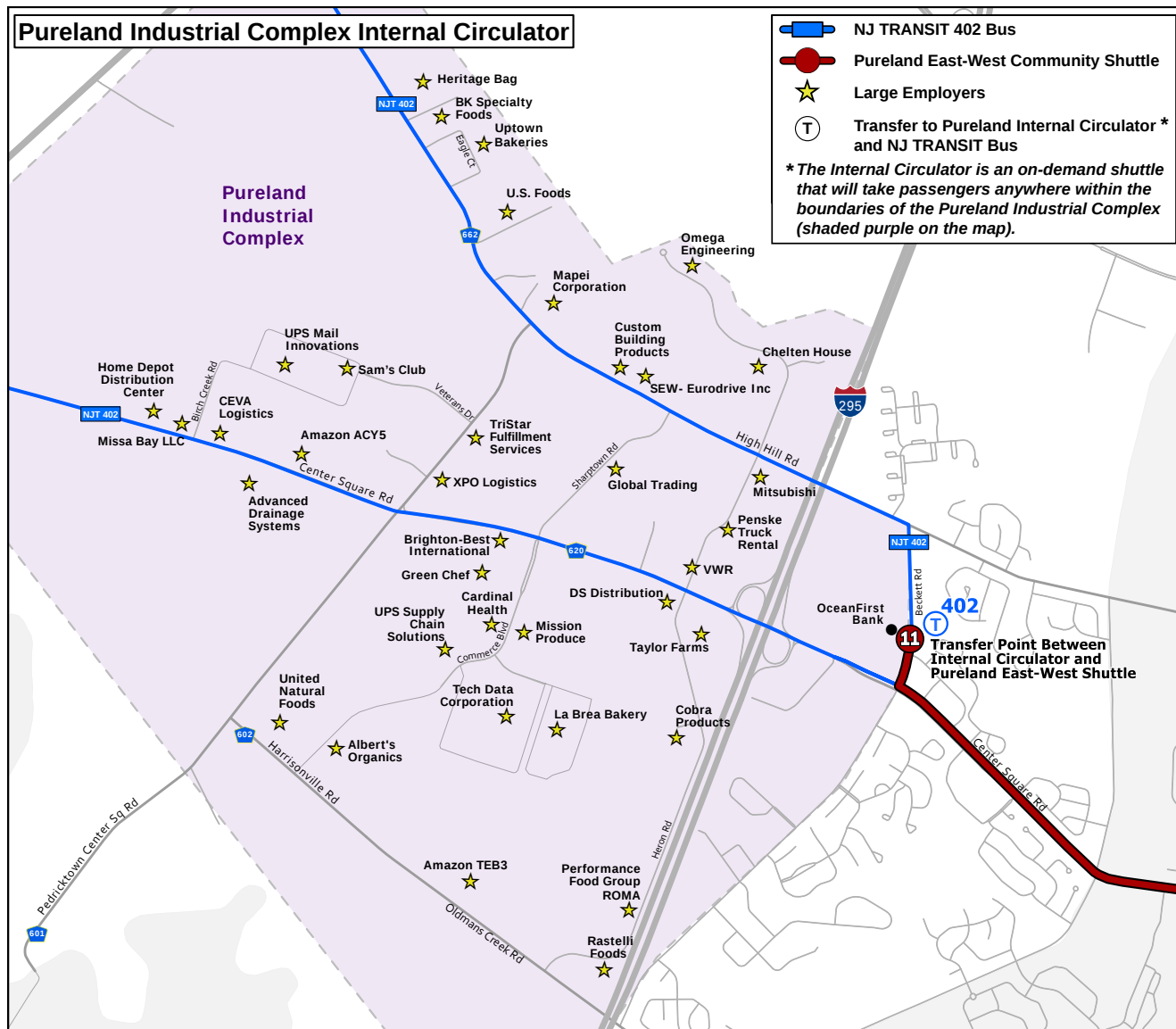

### Pureland Industrial Complex Internal Circulator

The Internal Circulator connects with the Pureland East-West Community Shuttle at Village Center Dr (Stop #11), and serves businesses within the Pureland Industrial Complex, between 4:30 AM and 6:40 PM. The Internal Circulator is an on-demand service that travels anywhere within the bounds of the Industrial Complex.

**How does it work?** When transferring to the Internal Circulator, tell the driver where you work, and The Internal Circulator will take you there. Be sure to let the driver know when you would like to be picked up at the end of your shift, and The Internal Circulator will take you back to the Pureland East-West Community Shuttle for your return trip. If you do not have an opportunity to make arrangements with the driver, call SJTA Customer Service to schedule your pick-up and drop-off in advance at 856-227-7571.

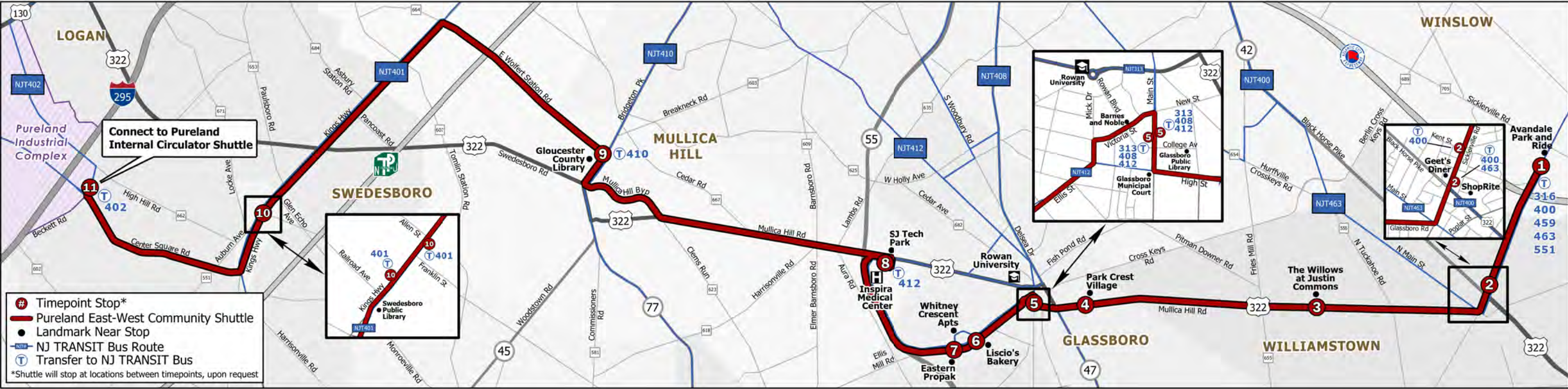
