This waiver applies specifically to a convenience use basement bathroom with an ejector pump. Any additional bar sink, kitchenette sink, dishwasher, utility sink, or any plumbing fixture that would require waste water to be disposed of via an ejector pump would not be convenience use and require the septic tank AND field bed be upgraded accordingly. Please submit a floor plan of the proposed basement renovations with this waiver for review.

1. The existing or proposed use of the ejector pump is for a convenience bathroom only. No other ejector pumps may be installed nor any other waste be discharged through the convenience use basement bathroom ejector pump.
2. All existing system components to be used in the system must be inspected in accordance with the inspection requirements of N.J.A.C. 7:9A-12.6. The Gloucester County Health Department does not issue waivers for existing systems where there might be an existing problem that could be exacerbated.
3. The system must be altered to meet all current requirements for pretreatment units. If a septic tank is to be used, it must meet the 50% oversizing requirements, multiple compartments (or separate tanks in series), and an effluent filter at least 6" in diameter. Alternatively, an advanced wastewater pretreatment unit may be used in addition to or possibly in lieu of a septic tank.
