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**WELL CONSTRUCTION SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS FOR PUBLIC
NON-COMMUNITY WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM**

Note: Public non-community water system serves a non-residential population of 25 or more people for at least 60 days out of the year.

The following items must be submitted for review by the Gloucester County Department of Health prior to well and distribution system installation. Please submit **3** copies of the following applications and attachments along with the well construction application fee of \$125.00. (Check or money order must be made out to “County of Gloucester”):

1. Completed Well construction application.
2. Completed Public Non-community (PNC) well application checklist
3. Completed PNC distribution system application checklist (discharge/service line or water main from well to building(s))
4. Municipal Utilities Authority (MUA) waiver for the following municipalities: Clayton, Deptford, Mantua, Monroe, and Washington.
5. Board of Health approvals are required to be obtained prior to approval from this Department for the following municipalities: Deptford Township and West Deptford Township. A letter of approval or approval stamp must accompany your well application.
6. Well permit approved by NJDEP—Bureau of Water Allocation and Well permitting.
7. Manufacturer specifications of well pump (Well pump must be NSF 61 certified).
8. Diagram (s) showing location of all municipal boundaries, roads, streams, sanitary sewers, storm water sewers and drainage channels, test wells, wells fields, all existing and proposed water supply and sewage disposal facilities, all distribution mains, service lines, and potential sources of contamination within 200 feet of each proposed well. Please be advised that a raw tap immediately followed by a check valve must be installed for each water source and location shown on diagram.
9. Public non-community non-transient proposed water system (New construction or expansion) must also submit information demonstrating technical, managerial and financial capacity in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:10-13.5 and 13.6. (Public Non-community non-transient system serves a non-residential population of 25 or more of the same people daily for 6 month or more out of the year).
