Non-Discrimination Policy

Gloucester County operates its programs and services without regard to race, color, or national origin in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended. Any person who believes that she or he has been aggrieved by any unlawful discriminatory practice under Title VI may file a complaint in writing Gloucester DIVISION OF HUMAN & DISABILITY SERVICES, 115 Budd Blvd, West Deptford, NJ 08096. Transportation services provided by this agency are in whole or part funded through federal funds received through NJ TRANSIT and as an individual you also have the right to file your complaint to both Gloucester County as well as the Federal Transit Administration, by writing to: Title VI Program Coordinator, East Building, 5th floor -TCR, U.S. Dept. of Transportation, Federal Transit Administration, Office of Civil Rights, 1200 New Jersey Ave., SE, Washington, DC 20590. A complaint must be filed within 180 days of the alleged discrimination.
