**\*Please note: For the FREE exercise classes, a video may be used in place of a live class or a class may be cancelled if the program coordinators decide it's necessary due to unforeseen circumstances, vacation days, office duties/training or low attendance.**

**LET'S GET FIT!** – No Cost - A fun mix of different chair & standing exercises.  
This is a great class for beginners & those experienced in exercise.

**BANDS** – No Cost – Exercise working on your strength using resistance bands.

**INTENSE** – No Cost – Intense Chair - Get Movin' & Groovin' with this upbeat, FAST-paced chair exercise. Be ready to sweat & challenge yourself!

**STRENGTH** – No Cost – Strength Training – Total body strength training! Seated & standing exercises.

**CHAIR YOGA** – Cost: \$5 – low-impact, gentle exercise that helps with posture, improving flexibility, strength and balance, while reducing stress and can increase social connection and mental well-being.

**TAI CHI** – Cost: \$5 – Focus on Calming your Mind, Controlling Your Body Movements, Breathing, Balance & Enhance your Immune System

**ZUMBA** – Cost: \$5 – Get your body moving and dance on your feet with Zumba Gold for Seniors.

**CHAIR ZUMBA** – Cost: \$3 – Get your body moving and dance with chair Zumba for Seniors.

**CRAFT CLASS** – No Cost – Benefits of crafting: aids in mind and brain wellness, helps the development of hand-eye coordination and spatial awareness, gives a sense of pride and achievement, teaches you patience and perseverance, encourages active creativity, and facilitates memory formation and retrieval.

### **TRIP SIGN UP PROCEDURE**

All trips are first come, first serve. A waiting list will be kept if seats become available once the trip is full. New trips will be added each month to our monthly calendar. We advertise trips anywhere from 3 months to 6 months or more in advance. To sign up, please stop in the office during hours, Monday - Friday, 9am – 3pm. Cash, Checks & most Credit Cards are accepted. We do not accept American Express. You have the option to save your credit card on file.

### **TRIP PARKING PROCEDURE**

Please park in the parking lot on the side of the building where the flagpole is located. Please DO NOT park along the fence in front of the building near the front door. These spaces are for people visiting the building throughout the day.

### **CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY**

\*Payments on trips with multiple installments need to be made in a timely manner; otherwise, we reserve the right to offer your seat to someone else.

\*In order to receive any type of refund, you must cancel before the trip date and may be refunded AFTER the trip date ONLY IF we are able to fill your seat. We will try our best to fill your seat if a waiting list is available. If a wait list is available, your spot is nontransferable to a friend/family member.

Please do not give your seat to a friend/family member without speaking with us first. The wait list is the best way to keep this as fair as possible for all.

\*Refunds will not be issued to “no shows” & cancellations on the day of the trip or if we are unable to fill your cancelled seat with another paying traveler.

### **TRIP PROCEDURE**

All trip departure and return times are listed in our calendar under each trip.

Please arrive 15 minutes before the listed departure time. All trips depart from & return to the Glassboro Senior Center. We try to estimate the return time the best we can, which can be affected by traffic & other circumstances. Please note: The return time is the best estimate we can provide. Please meet in the Senior Center to check in for the trip and names will be called in sign up order once we are ready to load the bus.

It is required every person exit the bus when the bus is dropping us off at any location. No one can stay on the bus alone or while the bus is parked.

This is just an interest list to help us fill cancelled seats so the person cancelling has a chance of receiving a refund once we fill the seat with another paying traveler.
