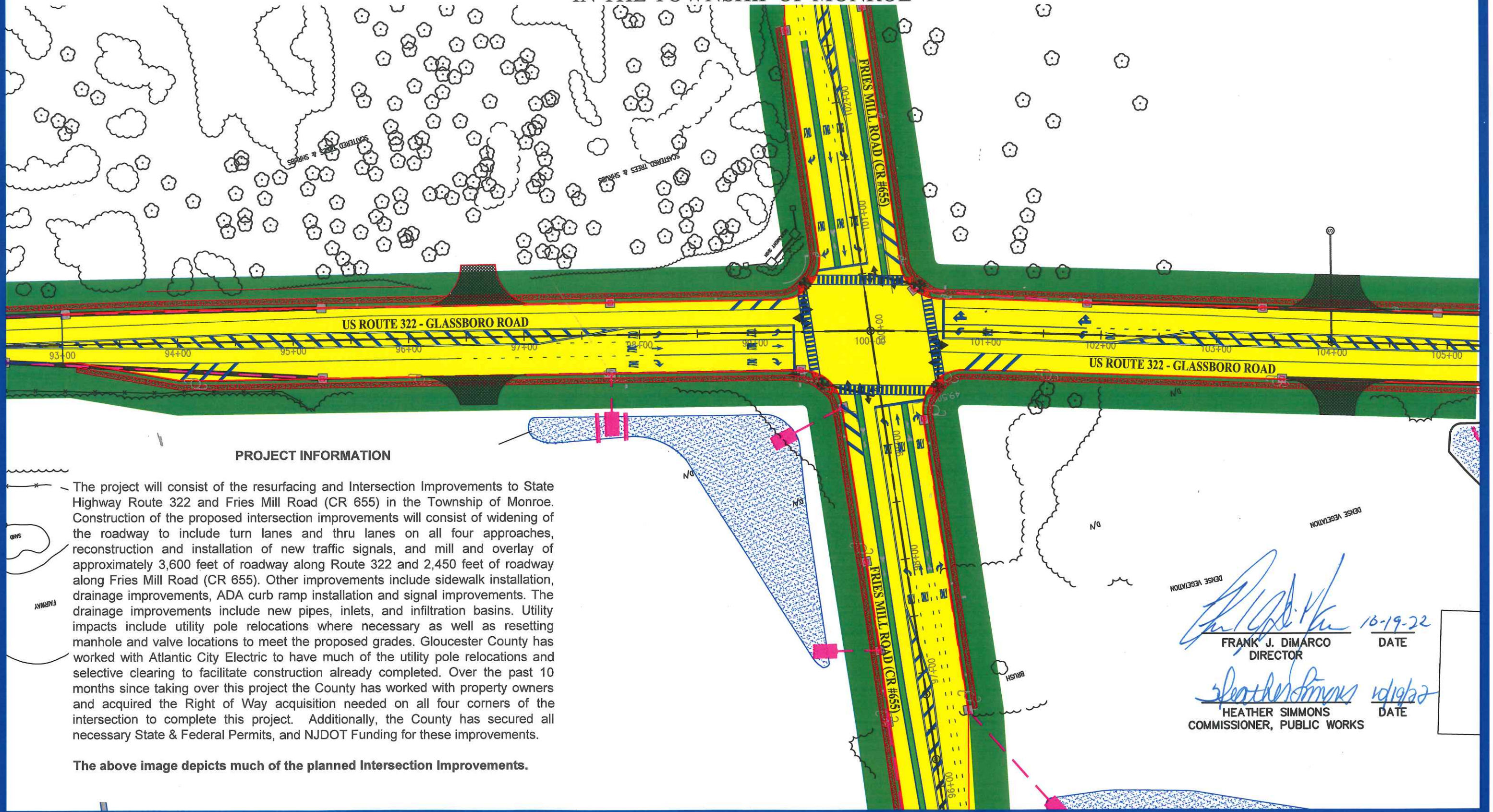




COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER

 GLASSBORO ROAD (US ROUTE 322) AND FRIES MILL ROAD (CR 655)
 IN THE TOWNSHIP OF MONROE



PROJECT INFORMATION

The project will consist of the resurfacing and Intersection Improvements to State Highway Route 322 and Fries Mill Road (CR 655) in the Township of Monroe. Construction of the proposed intersection improvements will consist of widening of the roadway to include turn lanes and thru lanes on all four approaches, reconstruction and installation of new traffic signals, and mill and overlay of approximately 3,600 feet of roadway along Route 322 and 2,450 feet of roadway along Fries Mill Road (CR 655). Other improvements include sidewalk installation, drainage improvements, ADA curb ramp installation and signal improvements. The drainage improvements include new pipes, inlets, and infiltration basins. Utility impacts include utility pole relocations where necessary as well as resetting manhole and valve locations to meet the proposed grades. Gloucester County has worked with Atlantic City Electric to have much of the utility pole relocations and selective clearing to facilitate construction already completed. Over the past 10 months since taking over this project the County has worked with property owners and acquired the Right of Way acquisition needed on all four corners of the intersection to complete this project. Additionally, the County has secured all necessary State & Federal Permits, and NJDOT Funding for these improvements.
