

| Exact Fare-On many bus routes, passengers are required to have exact fare in coins or \$1 bills. Drivers do not carry money and cannot make change. ## Access link

Access Link is a public transportation service established to comply with the paratransit regulations of the ADA. Access Link service is comparable to the NJ TRANSIT local fixed route bus and light rail systems. Access Link is for people with disabilities who are unable to use the local fixed route bus for some or all of their rides. ## Pureland East-West Shuttle

The Pureland East-West shuttle is a service provided by a partnership between Gloucester County, Pascal Sykes Foundation, South Jersey Transportation Authority, United Way of Gloucester County, People for People, NJ Transit & Cross County Connections. The Pureland East-West shuttle runs Monday thru Friday from 4:54 am to 8:00 pm. The shuttle has stops between the Pureland Industrial Park in Logan Township and Avandale Park & Ride in Sicklerville including stops in Logan, Swedesboro, Mullica Hill (Gloucester County Library), Harrison (Inspira Hospital), Glassboro (Eastern Propak, Liscio's Bakery, Park Crest Village) & Williamstown (The Willows at Justin Commons, Geet's Diner). The shuttle fare is 1\$ each way exact change required. Fare is free for one zone rides connecting to NJ Transit routes. An internal shuttle for the Pureland Industrial Park is also available when arriving at the internal circulator stop along with an internal shuttle to get to the Commodore Business Park located on US-322. When boarding the internal circulator inform the driver on where you want to be dropped off and what time to be picked up. The driver will return you to the Pureland East-West shuttle stop for your return trip.
